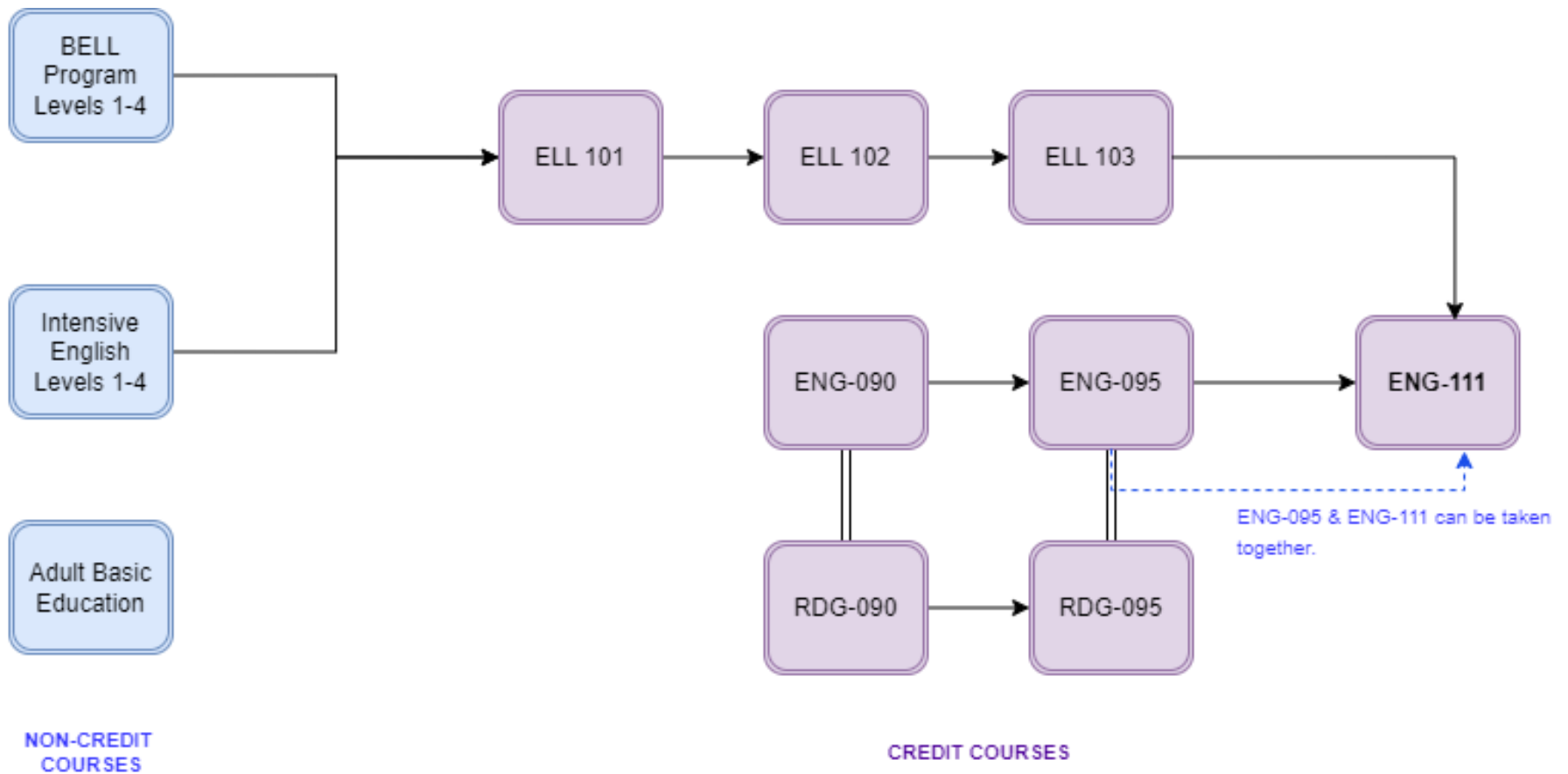

ACCUPLACER TESTING: ESL vs STANDARD VERSIONS

Before you start the Accuplacer English test, you will answer three background questions. These questions determine if you take the standard Accuplacer tests (WritePlacer and Reading) or the ESL Accuplacer tests (WritePlacer ESL and ESL Reading).

Question 1: Is English the only language you speak?

YES: Go to WritePlacer.

NO: Go to Question 2.

Question 2: Have you studied English for six (6) years or more in the U.S. or in a country where English is the primary language of instruction?

YES: Go to Question 3.

NO: Go to WritePlacer ESL.

Question 3: Do you speak, read, and write English daily?

YES: Go to WritePlacer.

NO: Go to WritePlacer ESL.
