Diaper Lottery Program Overview

- Students/staff will <u>request diapers</u>
 <u>online</u> every month during the first week of the month
- During the second week of the month,
 DISH staff will randomly select 45
 applicants to receive diapers
- During weeks 2&3 of every month, we will order and receive the diapers in the sizes that the lottery winners need
- We will communicate your pickup window via email, and you will have 1-2 weeks to pick up after we have received your diapers in the pantry.

Additional Information

- 1. If you do not receive diapers in September, you can re-apply in October
- 2. If you do receive diapers in September, you can re-apply in November
- 3. DISH points no longer apply to diapers those points can be used for all other items available on Smart Choice
- 4. Diaper pick-ups will not count towards the DISH monthly limit of 2 orders per month
- 5. You must be a registered DISH user to enter the Diaper Lottery. You can register at: bhcc.edu/dishfoodpantry
- 6. We ask that only those with young children in their immediate household enter the lottery

Why are we switching to this system?

Due to funding and staffing constraints, we are not able to distribute diapers to every family in our community who needs them.

We are hopeful that switching to this system will allow for more equal access to all who need diapers for their children.

DISH DIAPER LOTTERY

How to request free diapers beginning Sept 1st, 2024:

- Become a registered DISH user, if you have not already. Go to bhcc.edu/dishfoodpantry to fill out our intake form or scan the OR code below.
- Fill out the **Diaper Request form** at the start of each month (QR code below).
- 3. DISH staff will randomly select approximately 45 students and staff to receive diapers in the size that your family needs. Schedule a time to pick up the last week of the month.
- 4. DISH users will be eligible receive free diapers through the lottery **once every 2 months.**

- B101, 11-3 M-F
- G Building student lounge, 3-7pm M-F
- Chelsea student lounge, 10-3 M-Th

Grocery Pickup - Online ordering, by appointment only

Pantry staples, produce, baby food, hygiene supplies, some specialty items

- Sign up at <u>bhcc.edu/dishfoodpantry</u>
- Students have 35 points to spend per month; faculty/staff have 30 points
