

Affidavit of Support Form

International applicants who require an I-20 must show a proof that they have sufficient funds to support themselves for their study at BHCC. View the estimated cost of attendance on the following page.

If an applicant will have a sponsor, an affidavit of support must be submitted along with the sponsor's bank statement or letter with an original signature of the bank official. An applicant may have multiple sponsors. Each sponsor must complete the Affidavit of Support and sign it. For each sponsor a copy of the bank statement/letter must be submitted. The financial document/bank statement cannot be older than six (6) months. You will be required to submit a copy of the Affidavit of Support and bank letter or statement to the U.S. Embassy or Consulate with your visa application.
