Scope and Contents

The College Events record group dates between 1975 to 2025 and consists of various events held throughout the college's history. Some examples of these events include commencement, convocation, guest speaker events such as the Compelling Conversation, One Book, and Difficult Dialogue speaker series, guest music performances, and conferences held at BHCC. The materials are in text-based formats such as flyers, programs, booklets, memoranda, press releases, letters, invitations, handouts, emails, and newspaper clippings.

This collection is arranged into 17 series and 5 sub-series. Each series is arranged chronologically.

Series 3: Anniversaries (RG017.03)
