Scope and Contents

The Alumni Association record group documents the activities of Bunker Hill Community College's Alumni Association between 1983 and 2007 through records of meetings, articles on the achievements of alumni, association

publications, and other administrative documents. A substantial portion of the record group are meeting materials for the association, including agendas, minutes, and memoranda. Another sizeable part of the collection are copies of the alumni newsletter, the *Alumni Connection*, from 1988 to 2005. The formats of materials in the record group are all paper-based items like communications, agendas, minutes, newspaper clippings, reports, newsletters, and invitations.

Arrangement

This collection is arranged in five series, and each series is in chronological order.

Collection Inventory

Series 1: Alumni Administration (RG018.01)

The first series consists of one folder with items from 1998 to 2004. These items document the administration of the BHCC Alumni Association through meeting materials, communications, and reports. A sizable portion of the series consists of minutes and agendas for the association, including both regular and annual meetings. There is also documentation on officers and members of the association, activity reports, and association bylaws. This series is arranged chronologically.

Series 2: Alumni Publications (RG018.02)

The second series contains one folder, and the contents date between 1983 and 2005. This series entirely consists of newsletter publications from alumni, and almost every publication within is the *Alumni Connection* newsletter. There is a copy of another newsletter, the *Bunker Hill Community College Alumni Association*, which appears to have been an earlier version of the *Alumni Connection*. These newsletters provide updates on the college, alumni achievements, and association proceedings. All items are arranged chronologically.

Series 3: Open Letters (RG018.03)

The third series includes one folder with an item from 2000. This document is an open letter from BHCC math faculty member Herbert Gross to the college community documenting the inaccuracies of an article on the college in the January/February 2000 issue of the “Community Colleges Urban Report.” Gross provides his own perspective on the contributions of each president and the college’s early years.

Series 4: Alumni Activities (RG018.04)

The fourth series consists of one folder with an item from 2001. This series highlights activities and events organized by the Alumni Association, and there is currently one item in the folder. This item is an invitation to the 2001 annual winter getaway hosted by the association.

Series 5: Alumni News and Achievements (RG018.05)

The fifth series contains one folder with items from 2006 and 2007. This series documents the achievements and lives of BHCC alumni in newspaper clippings. Many clippings describe the Harvard graduation of one alum, Elizabeth Veronica McNeil, but there are also clippings documenting other alumni in their careers and their achievements in the Boston area. The items in this series are arranged chronologically.
