## Scope and Contents

The BHCC in Television and Cinema record group dates between 1997 to 2001 documenting media coverage and correspondence regarding BHCC's usage in 1997's "Good Will Hunting," and the 2001 pilot for the television show, "Crossing Jordan." The materials are predominantly text-based consisting of memorandums, newspaper clipping, letters, press releases, and a screenplay.

## **Collection Inventory**

### **Series 1: Good Will Hunting (RG026.01)**

The first series consists of one folder with the contents dated between 1997 to 1998. The series focuses on media coverage regarding BHCC's inclusion in the film, and BHCC professor John Reeves' involvement with Robin Williams' character in the film. There are additional memos regarding the college using the film as part of a marketing campaign. The series is text-based consisting of newspaper clippings, letters, and press releases.

The second series consists of one folder focusing on BHCC's likeness being used in the pilot episode of the television show, Crossing Jordan.
