EMT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Activate to support the Campus Community</li> <li>• Coordinate with first responders and medical personnel</li> <li>• Activate the Psychological Crisis Annex</li> </ul>
Public Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maintain perimeter and restrict unauthorized access to the facility</li> <li>• Coordinate emergency vehicle access to the campus</li> <li>• Liaison to first responders</li> </ul>
Public Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Coordinate all emergency communication platforms</li> <li>• Liaise with the media</li> <li>• Implement the EMT communications strategy</li> <li>• Evaluate communications and record for future reference.</li> </ul>

## Scope

BHCC has limited capacity to deal with a Mass Casualty Incident and would rely on state and local first responders and medical professionals.
